ONE VALIDATE DIAGNOSIS

- Did you know that 50% of batteries that are warranted are still good batteries?
- Did you load test your battery and verify that the state of charge is at least 12.4 volts?
- Did you have your electrical system tested?
 - Battery failure is a symptom of an electrical system problem (alternator, starter, connections, etc)
- Does your vehicle have a large amount of electrical loads/accessories such as NAV, DVD, high end stereo, electric doors, etc?
 - If so, consider an Optima/AGM battery that is designed for high cycling vehicle applications.

TWO BEFORE LEAVING AUTOZONE

- Make sure that the battery you choose meets or exceeds the OEM cranking specification available in Z-net
- Make sure that the battery size you choose is a suitable replacement for your year/make/model vehicle
 - Z-net is the source to find the best battery for your vehicle.
- Register your battery in our database for a hassle-free nationwide warranty.
- Be informed! Make sure you review all instructions included in the product box and available on Z-net.

THREE BEFORE INSTALLING

- Apply a Memory saver to your cigarette outlet to save your radio/seat presets (optional)
- Remove the battery heat shield (if applicable)
- Loosen and/or remove the battery hold down
- Disconnect the negative battery cable
- Disconnect the positive battery cable

FOUR RECOMMENDED TOOLS

- Wrenches and sockets
- Battery cables and/or terminals replacements
- Battery terminal protectors and sealant
- Haynes Repair Manual
