





1. Locate Your Manufacturer's Paint Code

Your car or truck's **Paint Code** is located on a Service Parts Identification plate. Locations vary by year and by GM vehicle model. (See Illustration A) The paint color code location for your model can be found below on the Service Parts Identification Plate Location Chart.

PRIOR to 1984

GM Group cars, except for Corvair and Corvette, have the identification plate under the hood on the upper left or right side of the firewall. For Corvair, locate the I.D. plate on the instruction panel brace below the glove compartment. Corvette owners should contact a local dealer for cars built before 1984.

1984 to PRESENT

GM Group cars made after Sept. 15, 1984 have a two-part color identification system. The Paint Code may follow "BC/CC" (base coat/ clear coat) and have an "L" or a "U." "U" is normally the body color. (See Illustration A).




