- Did you know it is important to check the entire system, including the operating pressures which can be found in the Haynes Techbook.
- . Did you check for restrictions?
  - Ensure correct engine cooling systems operations,
     i.e. Radiator, electric fan, fan clutch, fan blades & fan shroud.

# TWO BEFORE LEAVING AUTOZONE

- Always replace the receiver drier/accumulator and expansion device to validate your warranty
- · Purchase refrigerant, oil and flush.
- The vacuum pump and flush equipment you will need is in our FREE Loan-A-Tool® program.
- . Don't forget SAFETY! Wear goggles and gloves.
- Make sure you review all instructions included in the product box and available on Z-net.
- Register your air compressor in our database for a hassle-free nationwide warranty.

### THREE BEFORE INSTALLING

#### Flush ENTIRE system

- Some models may require condenser be replaced.
- Replace receiver drier/accumulator and expansion device
  - Failure to replace these components is a leading cause of failure in the replacement compressor.
- . Distribute oil evenly throughout the components
  - Hose
  - Accumulator
  - Receiver drier

### FOUR AFTER INSTALLING

- . Manually turn compressor 12 revolutions to distribute oil & lubricate compressor
  - Spanner wrench may be required
- Evacuate and recharge system to 0E specs which are available in Z-net.
