

CRANK HOLD FEATURE

2003 and Newer
Toyota Sequoia, Land Cruiser w/4.7L
4Runner w/4.0L and 4.7L
Tundra w/3.4L and 4.7L Double Cab

Condition: Owners of these vehicles may comment that the engine starter will continue to crank after key is released. This is a normal condition and no repairs should be attempted. The Power Control Module (PCM) controls the starter relay on input from the key switch.

When the key is held in the start position for 0.4 seconds, the PCM start timer is activated and will continue to crank the starter until the engine starts or a start time limit is reached. This system was put in place to improve starting and starting system reliability.
