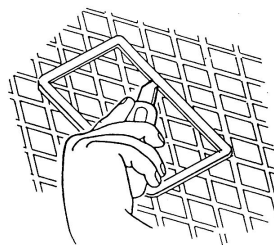

Helpful Hint: This Cargo Liner has been rolled for ease of shipment. To allow the Cargo Liner to unroll properly, simply leave out (logo side facing down) at room temperature for a few hours or overnight. It will return to its original shape.

Installation:

1. This Cargo Liner is designed to cover the entire cargo area of your vehicle, extending rearward from behind the second row of seats to the rear hatch. It may be used with two or three rows of seats.
2. For optimum floor protection, do not cut, trim or alter your Cargo Liner in any way. However, if your vehicle is equipped with three rows of seats and you want to continue to use the third seat, and still keep the Cargo Liner in place, you may cut out the (4) large and (1) small center rectangular embossed areas on the Cargo Liner. Using a sharp tool, such as a utility or carpet knife, cut along the inside edge of the embossment as shown in the figure below.
3. The two smaller rectangular embossments on the lower right and left sides, when cut in similar fashion, will provide clearance for the attachment of the third seat seatbelt mountings, if applicable. To disconnect the seatbelt mountings from the floor, simply depress the red button found on the seatbelt buckle (at floor level) and pull seatbelts away from the floor.

WARNING: It is essential that you re-engage the seat belts to the vehicle floor before carrying passengers in the third seat.



Cleaning:

- This Cargo Liner is resistant to most fluids. Use caution when transporting corrosive chemicals. Should a spill occur, remove the Cargo Liner immediately and rinse with water.
 - Remove heavy soiling by washing with a mild detergent and warm water. The Cargo Liner's bottom surface must be dry before re-installing in vehicle.
 - To keep the Liner gleaming, wipe with clean cloth and automotive vinyl or leather cleaners.
- Note: Use of cleaning fluids other than soap and water may make the surfaces slippery.
